JUNIOR ART ENCOUNTERS - 5-8 years

Our Junior Artists program seeks to give students a rounded experience of a variety of art processes that will enrich and expand their knowledge of art and ability to make it. Each term is divided into a number of units.

The following is the program for the next term:

TERM ONE 2019

UNIT ONE: DECORATIVE FLOWER VASES

In this three-week project students will learn how to break an image down through drawing and the effects of layering paint to achieve a range of colours whilst slowly building a finished work of art. Inspired by the painting by Marcus Oakley a UK graphic designer.



UNIT TWO: DRAWING REPTILIAN CREATURES

In this project students will learn how to draw a snake using a variety of mediums and approaches. Children will learn how to apply different kinds of drawing materials including pencil, pastels, ink and wash to develop a range of interesting and rich drawings.





UNIT THREE: COLLAGE: GEOMETRIC ABSTRACTIONS

Students will assemble their own series of geometric shape abstractions using coloured tissue paper and collage. Through the process of layering shapes over each other each student will create an amazing and colourful collage artwork that will teach them about colour, creativity and above all, patience.



IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER:
